APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

RESOLUTIONS

1. Free Holiday Parking

A motion was made by Mr. Celli, seconded by Mr. Ovial, to approve the proposal submitted by Verizon to relocate overhead cables at the Public Works site in the amount of \$10,500. This amount will be paid from the 2016 Bond Issue. Voice vote; all in favor. Motion carried.

Parks/Recreation: (DeCaria, Mancini, Dici)

1. Award Bid – Tennis Court Rehabilitation Project (milling/paving)

A motion was made by Ms. Dici, seconded by Mr. DeCaria, to approve the bid from McElroy Paving Co. (Ingomar, PA) in the amount of \$57,861 for the Ewing Park Tennis Court Rehabilitation Project (milling/paving). This amount will be paid from the Marcellus Shale Fund. Voice vote; all in favor. Motion carried.

2. <u>Advertise Bids – Tennis Court Rehabilitation Project – Phase II (surface treatment/line painting)</u>

A motion was made by Mr. DeCaria, seconded by Ms. Mancini, to authorize Taylor Engineering to prepare/advertise bids for the Tennis Court Rehabilitation Project – Phase II (surface treatment/line painting). Voice vote; all in favor. Motion carried.

3. Payment (ratify) – Mr. Fence

A motion was made by Ms. Dici, seconded by Ms. Lamenza, to approve the year 2018 cost of living adjustment for retired police officers William Betz, Brian Damon, Chris Hardie, and John Lubich (DROP), as submitted by the Actuary. Voice vote; all in favor. Motion carried.

4. <u>Set Public Hearing – Vacate Portion of Fifth Street</u>

A motion was made by Ms. Mancini, seconded by Ms. Lamenza, to set a public hearing for December 11 at 5:45pm on the matter of vacating a portion of Fifth Street from south line of Rear Summit Avenue to the north line of Aiken Avenue at the request of Dan & Marsha Glover. Voice vote; all in favor. Motion carried.

5. Approve Quote – M&P Security Solutions

A motion was made by Mr. DeCaria, seconded by Ms. Mancini, to approve the quote from M&P Security Solutions (Baden, PA) in the amount of \$8,519 to install security cameras in Pittsburgh Circle Heritage Park. This amount will be paid from the Park Improvement Fund. Voice vote; all in favor. Motion carried.

6. <u>Authorize 422 Auction to Sell 2006 Chrysler Sebring</u>

A motion was made by Ms. Dici, seconded by Mr. Ovial, to authorize 422 Auction to sell the 2006 Chrysler Sebring. Voice vote; all in favor. Motion carried.

7. <u>Worker's Compensation Insurance – Firefighters</u>

A motion was made by Ms. Dici, seconded by Ms. Lamenza, to approve the Workers Compensation Insurance with the State Workers Insurance Fund (SWIF) for the volunteer firefighters for the period 1/1/18 - 1/1/19. The estimated annual premium is \$23,772 (final premium is subject to adjustment by audit). This amount will be paid from the General Fund. Voice vote; all in favor. Motion carried.

1. <u>Subdivision – Vince & Patty Riccio</u>

2. <u>Accept Proposal – CT Consultants</u>

The Borough is seeking \$420,500. If successful, the Borough's match will be 74,300, payable from the Sewage Collection Reserve Fund. Voice vote; all in favor. Motion carried.
