1. Loading/Unloading Zone – Birch Way

1. <u>Submission of 2023 CDBG Application</u>

Therefore, \$67,782.22 is owed to the Firemen's Plan, \$194,787.24 is owed to the Municipal Employees Plan and a balance of \$215,654.24 is owed to the Police Plan. Further, it is moved that these balances be paid by the General Fund by December 31, 2023. Roll call vote; all in favor. Motion carried.
