ELLWOOD CITY ELECTRIC EXTENDED PAYMENT PLAN

When a residential customer receives a notice of delinquency, he/she must apply for an extended payment plan unless payment is being paid IN FULL

EXTENDED PAYMENT PLAN CONDITIONS

- 1. Payment plan shall not exceed 90 days after original due date.
- 2. Agreed amounts are payable for 30 60 90 day periods.
- 3. If amounts are not paid under the current agreement, plans for a second extended plan **SHALL NOT** be granted.
- 4. It is understood and made clear to persons receiving extended payment plans that current bills **MUST** also be paid and cannot be made part of the current extended plan.
- 5. If the residential customer is a tenant or person other than the property owner, the payment plan shall be subject to the property owner's or landlord's written approval.
- 6. The completed plan must be approved by a Borough electric employee or Borough Manager.
- 7. <u>If delinquencies relative to the plan continue, the residential service will be terminated.</u>
